**PC** - Windows 7 is compatible with all current Epson drivers. The X900/EFI RIP is not compatible with 7 at this time - use XP.

## The Top 4 Questions we get at JVH

1. **"My prints are too dark."** Actually the monitor may be too bright. Hold up your blank media to the monitor and lower the monitor luminosity so the white of the media/paper matches the white in your application.
2. **"I've loaded a new Mac OS and now my prints have a magenta cast and suck."** The crappy GIMP drivers are kicking in. Load Rosetta plus you need to select Add Printer, then **"Epson USB"** or **"Epson TCP/IP"**, not just USB or TCP/IP.
3. **"Help! My printer doesn't work - - error code 0040 or 0002, plus ink marks on prints. Have Ryan call me."** We're here to help anybody, whether or not you bought the printer from us. Call us and we will bail you out.
4. **"Can I print water-resistant signage."** Yes.

## Some nice Epson Rebates

Incidentally, a rebate is generally **not** considered taxable, so you can write off the equipment cost yet take the rebate \$\$ straight in, making it worth even more. Be sure you verify the accounting tax rules for your scenario. Here's the rebate scoop:

### Epson 4880 - \$500.

Buy a **SP4880** 17"-wide printer and get a **\$500.** rebate by mail

- valid for orders placed by January 31

### Epson 7900 - \$900.

Buy a **SP7900** 24"-wide printer and get a **\$900.** rebate by mail

- valid Jan 1 thru March 31

### Epson 9900 - \$900.

Buy a **SP9900** 44"-wide printer and get a **\$900.** rebate by mail

- valid Jan 1 thru March 31

### Epson GS6000 - \$3,000.

Buy a **GS6000** 64"-wide solvent printer and get a **\$3,000.** instant rebate

- valid for orders placed by March 31

### Epson 7900/9900 ProofingEd - \$1,000.

Buy a **SP7900** 24" Proofing Edition printer or a **SP9900** 44" Proofing Edition printer and get a **\$1000** rebate by mail

- valid for orders placed by March 31
