## ColorByte ImagePrint 6.0 Update

The new Mac OS10 version of ImagePrint 6.0 is shipping by the end of March; the Windows version by the end of April. If you purchase the current 5.6 version now, you will receive a **free upgrade** to 6.0. If you purchased ColorByte from JVH and are eligible for a free update, we will submit your dongle number to ColorByte and request the new encryption for you.

## Digital Print Framing Tips

**Under-glass Gas Ghosting** - Ink jet printer users may occasionally notice that an ink jet photo framed behind glass has **fogged** the inside of the glass surface. This fog, which may look like a ghost image, is a film caused by ink solvents that have not completely "cured." This can happen on **any** "barrier"-type paper using **any** type of ink from **any** manufacturer if you do not allow the print to properly dry before framing. (A "barrier" paper is one with coatings designed to prevent ink from being absorbed completely into the paper, thus producing a brighter or glossier image - e.g. RC papers.)

Because there has been some confusion about the causes and the solutions for this occurrence, Epson wanted to clarify the steps to either prevent this from happening or fix the situation if your framed photos have already been affected. The basic solution is to place non-coated paper **between** the prints versus simply air drying, but there is **more to it** than just that. If you are interested, please drop us a line and we will e-mail you the **complete PDF** on what Epson recommends to eliminate this phenomenon.
